**RE: Public Meeting Notification - Tuesday, April 16, 2019  
TLCI Bike Lane and Curb Bump Project Proposal**

The City of Lorain in coordination with the Lorain County Metroparks (LCMP) and Lorain County Public Health (LCPH) will be hosting a public meeting on a new and exciting Transportation for Livable Communities Initiative (TLCI) Project coming to Lorain.

The City of Lorain has proposed a bike lane and curb bump outs for East 31<sup>st</sup> Street, from Vine Avenue to Norfolk Avenue at the Black River Trail (LCMP) portion of the North Coast Inland Trail; project length is approximately two miles. The Lorain Bicycle and Pedestrian Facilities Connectivity Project has been fully funded by NOACA (Northeast Ohio Areawide Coordinating Agency).

Members of the general public are invited to the public meeting on Tuesday, April 16, 2019 from 5:30 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. at El Centro de Servicios Sociales located at 2800 Pearl Avenue in Lorain, Ohio.

At this public meeting, attendees will be able to see the preliminary designs, ask questions of city staff, receive an update on Lorain County Metroparks projects including Phase 3C trail project (2020), which will terminate at Lake Erie at Century Park in Lorain, receive safety tips and items from Lorain County Public Health, and provide comments on the proposed plans.
