### **FILING OF APPLICATION**

Application must be made on the regular application forms available in the office of the Lorain Civil Service Commission, 7<sup>th</sup> floor, Lorain City Hall, 200 West Erie Ave, Lorain, Ohio 44052 OR applications are also available online at [cityoflorain.org](http://cityoflorain.org). go under Civil Service Department and then Job Application and follow the 4 step instructions. The Civil Service will begin accepting applications on Thursday, January 16, 2020 through Thursday, December 31, 2020 on a **CONTINUOUS basis** from 9:00 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Applications may be submitted in person by you or your representative OR you may email directly to: [rosemary\\_white@cityoflorain.org](mailto:rosemary_white@cityoflorain.org). The office is closed on holidays and every day from approximately 12:00 to 1:00 p.m.

### **ELIGIBILITY**

Applicants must be a United States citizen or have legally declared their intentions of becoming one. Applicants must possess a high school diploma or G.E.D. Applicants must possess and show at time of application a valid driver's license issued by the state of residence.

All potential City of Lorain Civil Service classified employees will be required to successfully pass a background investigation and a basic pre-employment physical and drug test administered under the direction of the City of Lorain prior to their appointment. All potential candidates for this position will be required to take and pass a practical test administered by the Civil Service Commission and supervisory staff. A passing grade of seventy (70) percent must be achieved on this test.

### **QUALIFICATIONS**

- Must have ability to learn and do repairs and overhaul of all chlorine equipment and its safe operation
- Repair and overhaul multi-fuel engines, blowers;
- Ability to learn and do electrical repair work on motors, electric panels boards, motor starters, air conditioners, heating equipment and its safe operation such as boilers, steamers, heat exchangers, safety valves etc.
- Ability to learn and do plumbing work with plastic, lead, glass, silver, rubber and stone lined equipment and pipes;
- Must have ability to learn to work with hand tools, drill presses, lathe, grinder, micrometer; work with bearings, sleeves, shafts and all other equipment and duties related to the proper operation of the plant.
