### Winter bill assistance available

Many Ohio families are struggling to pay their bills because of COVID-19's impact on the economy. There are several resources available to help customers maintain or reconnect gas service.

- The <u>Winter Reconnect Order</u> went into effect October 5. Customers whose service has been shut off because of non-payment, or who have received a shutoff notice, can reconnect for \$175 plus a reconnection fee, no matter how much is owed. The order runs through April 21, 2021. Call Columbia Gas at 1-800-344-4077.
- The Winter Crisis Program begins November 1. This program provides grants to income-eligible customers who have either been shut off or are currently facing shut off. Those interested should contact their local <a href="Energy Assistance Provider">Energy Assistance Provider</a> to learn more and verify income. These organizations can also connect customers to other helpful assistance programs.
- Columbia Gas also offers a wide variety of <u>payment</u> <u>plans</u> to help make bills more manageable.

# Columbia's COVID-19 protocols

- Assessing their health daily

## Cold weather safety messages

#### Stop. Leave. Call

As temperatures continues to drop, we become increasingly reliant on gas to keep our homes comfortable. Gas is safe and reliable but for a variety of reasons, leaks can occur. Gas is colorless and odorless in its purest



form, but Columbia Gas adds an odorant called mercaptan to give it that distinctive sulfur-like rotten egg smell. If you catch the scent, STOP what you're doing, LEAVE the area immediately and from a safe place CALL 911 and Columbia Gas at 1-800-344-4077. Crews will respond 24/7/365 to ensure everything is safe. Even if you aren't sure whether it's a gas leak, always err on the side of caution and call. Potential leaks should never be ignored.

#### Carbon monoxide

Carbon monoxide is created when fuels burn incompletely. It's tasteless and odorless, but can become deadly if too much accumulates without proper venting. The most reliable way to know whether you have a leak is to have fully functioning carbon monoxide detectors at home, especially in areas where someone sleeps. Be sure to test the detectors once per month and replace the batteries every six months. If the carbon monoxide alarm sounds, or if residents suspect a carbon monoxide leak, they should STOP what they are doing, LEAVE the area immediately and from a safe place CALL 911 and Columbia Gas at 1-800-344-4077.
