The City of Lorain, Department of Building, Housing and Planning, is accepting applications from qualified non-profit organizations interested in providing services that address one or more of the public service needs outlined below and in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) 2020/2021 - 2024/2025. All applications will be subject to a risk assessment, be reviewed, scored, and ranked based on need, benefit, and organizational capacity, past support, success administering programs, CDBG eligibility, Con Plan priorities, local needs, and the amount of funding requested. This funding is a reimbursable grant and all grantees must be able to utilize the funding within a year of receiving the funds.
