



Lorain Police Safety Town 2019



Safety Town is located at Lorain High School,
2600 Ashland Ave, 1st Floor Art Room.

In conjunction with the Lorain Police Department and the Lorain City Schools, Safety Town will be open for all children living in the City of Lorain entering kindergarten in the fall of 2019.

Our Safety Town program is a one-week course that is designed to teach your child safe practices both at school and at home. The children are instructed on when, where, and how to cross the street, school bus safety, seat belt safety, fire safety, poison control and how to handle strangers.

Safety Town is conducted **Monday thru Thursday from 9:00 AM to 11:30 AM**. Safety Town sessions are scheduled for the weeks of **June 24th**, **July 8th**, **July 15th**, and **July 22nd**.

The registration form should be completed and returned to Mrs. Robin Smith as soon as possible. The classes are filled on a first come first serve basis beginning with the Lorain City Schools registration. Please fill out the attached form and mail to Ms. Robin Smith at 505 Allison Avenue, Lorain, Ohio 44052.

You will be contacted by telephone or email by Robin prior to the start of Safety Town as to the date your child is to attend. On your registration form, please select what week that you would prefer your child to attend. Please also select a second choice so that if your first choice is filled we can place your child in the second/next available opening. Robin will only contact those parents who submit a registration form with a valid and working telephone number or valid email address. If you do not have a telephone number, we will need a telephone number of a person who we can make contact with so that this information can be given to you.

Class sizes are limited. Again, this will be on a first come, first serve basis.

The Lorain Police Safety Town program is free of charge to all who attend. Only instructors and children will be allowed on the Safety Town course during the instruction periods.

Safety Town Information

- ❖ Class will begin promptly at **9:00 am** and end at **11:30 am**. Please be on time in dropping off and picking up your child.
- ❖ For security reasons, only instructors and children will be allowed inside of the classroom and the Safety Town course during the instructions periods.
- ❖ Please return the Child Identification Program permission form by Tuesday morning. The children will have their picture taken on Wednesday and their ID's given to them on Thursday.
- ❖ Please have your child wear closed toe shoes. No flip flops are allowed due to safety reasons.
- ❖ The children will ride the bikes in "Safety Town" on Tuesday and Thursday, if the weather is permitting.
- ❖ On Wednesday the children will be bused to the Fire Department for a tour, a lesson on fire safety and a demonstration from LifeCare. The children will return to Lorain High for pick up at the usual time.
- ❖ The class will receive their Safety Town t-shirt on Tuesday. Please have them wear it for Graduation on Thursday.
- ❖ Graduation will be on Thursday at 11:30 am in the Auditorium. Family members are encouraged to attend.

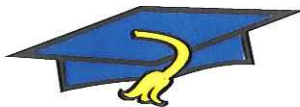

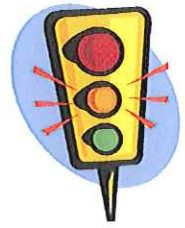
