Application must be made on the regular application forms available in the office of the Lorain Civil Service Commission, 7<sup>th</sup> floor, Lorain City Hall, 200 West Erie Avenue Lorain, Ohio or applications are also available online at [www.cityoflorain.org](http://www.cityoflorain.org) under departments click on Civil Service and then Job Application and follow the 4-step instructions. Applicants must also submit a resume as well as relevant training records and copy of college transcript. The Civil Service will be accepting applications **beginning Friday, OCTOBER 9, 2020 through Friday, October 16, 2020 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. The LAST day to submit applications will be Monday, October 19, 2020 by 10:00 A.M. The office is closed on holidays and everyday from approximately 12:00 to 1:00 p.m. for lunch.

Applicants **MUST** be certified by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy and have two (2) or more years of full or part time paid experience as Patrol Officer, preferably working in a municipality with a population of 5,000 or more.

Applicants must be a minimum of 21 years of age. Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent, a valid State of Ohio driver's license, be a US citizen and available to work on any shift on any day of the week. College education preferred but not required.

The City of Lorain Division of Police offers an exciting and rewarding career in urban law enforcement. Officers receive excellent benefits (medical, vision, life), and pension with the Ohio Police and Fire Pension Fund.
