LOR 110932 – Central Lorain Sidewalk Improvements (East and West 30th Street and Oakdale Ave.)

[LORAIN, OHIO] – The City of Lorain proposes to improve East and West 30th Street and Oakdale Avenue sidewalks within the City of Lorain, Lorain County, Ohio. The work includes removal and replacement of approximately 20% of the sidewalk that is past its useful life, upgrading all noncompliant curb ramps to the current ADA standard, improving crossings at intersections, and restoration landscaping. This project will run from Marshall Avenue to Clifton Avenue on West and East 30th Streets and from West 17th Street to West 30th Street on Oakdale Avenue. Construction is currently scheduled to begin in the Summer of 2022 and will last approximately 6 months.

Due to the proximity to private property, the City is seeking public input about the project in general. Questions and/or comments regarding this project may be directed to Veronica A.
