The City of Lorain's Public Service Programs are supported through the Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) funds. Our public information meetings for public service programs are held once a year in the month of July. We present to members of the community and community leaders to expand programming in the City to assist residents in need.

The City of Lorain, Department of Building, Housing, and Planning, is accepting applications from qualified non-profit organizations interested in providing services that address one or more of the public service needs outlined below and in the City's Five-Year Consolidated Plan (Con Plan) 2020/2021 - 2024/2025. The Con Plan can be found on the City of Lorain's website (cityoflorain.org).

- Food pantries
- Legal Services
- Homeless Services and Facilities
- Youth Services and Programs
- Senior Services and Programs
- Public Transportation and Services
- Mental Health Services

The City of Lorain will also be introducing their Pocket Program. This program consists of mini CDBG grants to assist nonprofit organizations with less than \$50,000 annual revenue or typically organizations that file a 990-EZ. Eligible programs are subject to and fall within the same requirements of regular public service. The mini-grants are between \$500.00 - \$5,000.00 depending on the size and scale of the project. This allows for the grant to be more manageable in accordance with HUD standards.
