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#### **LOR SR 0058 25.41, PID 120792- Tower Boulevard and SR-58 Traffic Signal Improvements**

The project improvements include the replacement of the existing traffic signal with a new traffic signal that has signal head backplates, pedestrian signals, new camera-based car detection, and new signage. Construction is scheduled to begin in May 2025 and will last for approximately seven months.

Traffic will be maintained through the construction zone, but motorists should expect construction phases that include lane reductions.

The overall construction cost for the project is anticipated to be \$323,054.22. Consulting Engineer: Michael Schweickart, PE, PTOE @ TMS Engineers, Inc. The Ohio Department of Transportation will generously fund 90% of this project cost and the remaining 10% will be funded by local dollars.

To make this project a success, the City is seeking public input about the project in general.
