The City of Lorain is accepting applications for the position of Police Officer via the Exceptional appointment process. Application must be made on the regular application forms which are available online at [www.cityoflorain.org](http://www.cityoflorain.org) under departments click on Civil Service and then Application Instructions and follow the 4-step instructions. Applicants must also submit a resume as well as relevant training records and copy of college transcript if applicable. Applicants must be certified by the Ohio Peace Officer Training Academy OR currently enrolled in an academy at time of application; full or part time paid experience as Patrol Officer preferred, and preferably working in a municipality with a population of 5,000 or more.

Applicants must be a minimum of 21 years of age. Applicants must have a high school diploma or equivalent, a valid State of Ohio driver's license, be a US citizen or have a valid permanent resident card and available to work on any shift on any day of the week. College education preferred but not required.
